Earle Travel Fellowship in Technology - Example

The **Richard and Mary Earle Travel Fellowship in Technology** is an annual grant of up to \$15,000 that helps fund overseas travel for young engineers, food technologists and food scientists, creating an opportunity for them to increase their professional knowledge and innovative skills through study or practical experience relevant to either:

- · product development and innovation management, or
- process development in bio-processing or food processing

It is envisaged that the skills gained, and the contacts made, through visiting overseas research and development institutes, and attending international conferences will enable successful candidates to contribute to improving technology in New Zealand.

The development of creativity and the generation of new product or process ideas for practical application are important elements of this fellowship and should be given due weight by candidates in their application.

Applicants must be:

- a) New Zealand citizens or permanent residents with at least three years proven residence in New Zealand immediately preceding the year of selection
- b) members of a professional organisation recognised by the Earle Technology Trust Board,
 [Engineering New Zealand, New Zealand Institute of Food Science and Technology, Institution of Chemical Engineers in New Zealand, or Product Development & Management Association]
- c) aged less than 40 years but with a preference given to candidates under 35 years
- d) employed in one of New Zealand's technological industries (products or services), or an associated research organisation. Note that students undertaking postgraduate study are not eligible for the fellowship. <u>The Dick and Mary Earle Scholarship in Technology</u> administered by Universities New Zealand supports postgraduate research into aspects of technology.

Selection criteria include:

- a) practical relevance of the proposed programme to New Zealand technological industries (products and services) including potential outcomes for innovative technologies and exports
- b) ability and previous experience of the candidate
- c) creativity and innovative ability demonstrated by the candidate
- d) support by the applicant's employer for the proposed trip.

Fellowship Conditions

The Fellow will:

- a) undertake travel overseas for a period of up to 3 months within 12 months of the fellowship being awarded,
- b) apply the fellowship money solely for travel, accommodation and associated costs, and fees associated with the intended professional development activities,
- c) return to New Zealand after completion of travel and work in New Zealand for at least one year, and
- d) provide a written report.
