For example: the context for exceptional leadership might be:

- Inspiring a group or team to deliver exceptional achievement
- Showing leadership beyond expectations for the position and/or experience level
- Sustained leadership excellence over a prolonged period
- Emergency or crisis response
- Effecting difficult change management

Eligibility criteria

- All current financial NZIFST members are eligible
- Nominees must be resident within New Zealand

Award comprises

- A trophy/plaque
- Reimbursement of expenses to \$500

To nominate/apply, please send

- Nomination is required by 2 NZIFST members (Standard, Professional or Fellow)
- A citation showing how the nominee meets the award purpose
- A CV or biography of no more than 2 pages
